Applying for a Mission Grant

The following funds of the Presbytery of Yellowstone are administered by the Mission Committee through a grant process. Grant applications will ordinarily be considered by the full committee. In time-sensitive cases, the moderator of the Mission Committee, in consultation with the committee members most closely affiliated with the area related to the grant request, will have authority to make decisions on grant requests. While every effort will be made to act quickly on your request, please do allow as much time as possible for consideration of your application.

Successful grant recipients are expected to report back to the committee in writing regarding how the funds were used and the impact of the project. Annual reporting is anticipated for on-going projects.

Brief Summary of the Funds

2 Cents a Meal - A local project of the Presbyterian Hunger Program. Small donations made at each meal become a fund for regional hunger relief.

Peacemaking - 25% of the Peacemaking Offering received in Yellowstone Presbytery churches stays with the presbytery, to be used for a presbytery Peacemaking Advocate or for peacemaking projects.

Pentecost - 10% of the Pentecost Offering received in Yellowstone Presbytery churches stays with the presbytery, to be used for ministries with children at risk and youth.

Restoring Creation - A grant from the General Assembly funded the work of a Restoring Creation Enabler. Money can be used for education or creation sensitive projects.

Proverbs 28-8 Fund - Interest earnings from the presbytery's main money market account, which can be used for mission that seeks economic justice for all God's children.
