# A special invitation to hear Rev. Ammer Issak from Lebanon on October 8th

On Monday, October 8, 2018, St. Andrew Presbyterian Church in Billings will host a talk at 6 p.m. by the Rev. Ameer Issak from Tyre, Lebanon. He and his wife Esther house and teach Syrian refugees in their church.

Rev. Ameer Issak is a pastor at the Tyre Evangelical Center in Tyre, Lebanon, in the National Evangelical Synod of Syria and Lebanon, a partner with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). This is a Reformed denomination, which is denoted in those countries by the term "Evangelical" which distinguishes it from the Catholic, Orthodox and Anglican churches.

Rev. Ameer serves a small congregation of about ten extended families. Rev. Ameer and his wife Esther live in one room of the church. The rest of the building houses a variety of ministries and outreach programs. They believe God has called them to embody Christ in love and service to Syrian refugees. Programs offered include Sunday morning worship and Sunday school, an elementary school for Christian and Muslim refugee children, a medical clinic, a food bank and livelihood classes for widowed Muslim and Christian women who are often unskilled and need to provide for their families.

Rev. Ameer and his translator Dani are visiting Wyoming Presbytery as part of that presbytery's partnership with the Tyre Evangelical Church in Lebanon and the Aleppo Evangelical Church in Syria.
