IMPROVING CONDITIONS FOR ORPHANS

Orphaned headed households receive food, clothing, blankets, personal hygiene kits, and medical care. School fees and uniforms are provided for these children. Orphans are fed two meals daily at the Heather Chimhoga Orphan Care Feeding Center.

YOU CAN HELP ORPHANS LIKE THESE BY DONATING:

- \$20/month to support an orphan
- Dresses for girls, no slacks or jeans
- Blouses & skirts
- Trousers/jeans for boys
- Shirts
- Underwear for boys & girls
- Socks & shoes for boys & girls
- Sweaters & sweat shirts
- Light weight jackets
- Hygiene Kits (washcloth, soap, shampoo, lotion, Vaseline, tooth brush and toothpaste, small toy or book wrapped inside a bath towel and packed in a shoebox if possible. Please seal liquids in a plastic bag.)

FOR SEWING & KNITTING CO-OPS:

- Light weight knitting yarn
- Sewing notions and sewing scissors

ENHANCING EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS

ZMP school projects include the repair and construction of school buildings, teacher's houses, and a bridge over a nearby river for children to use when walking to and from school. During this process, local builders have been taught more modern techniques in building and local people have been employed.

YOU CAN HELP SCHOOLS LIKE THESE BY DONATING:

- Spiral ring notebooks
- Pencils
- Erasures
- Pencil sharpeners
- Rulers
- Bic pens (blue or red ink)
- Packets of notebook paper - regular rule.
- Colored construction paper
- Crayons
- Coloring books for preschoolers
- Staples and staplers
- Transparent tape (Scotch tape)

YOU CAN HELP THE COMMUNITY BY DONATING:

- Clothing of all sizes

HEATHER CHIMHOGA ORPHAN CARE (HCOC)

The HCOC was established through a joint effort of the local community and the ZMP. Wells provide sanitary drinking water. Orphan Care Givers provide some guidance to the orphans. Each village contributes two acres of maize to show their support.

YOU CAN HELP THE HCOC BY DONATING:

- Blankets and towels
- Tooth brush and toothpaste
- Bath soap
- Vaseline
- Pencils, erasers & blue ink pens
- First aid supplies:
 - Neosporin
 - Hydrocortisone cream
 - Gauze pads, various sizes
 - Sterile rubber gloves
 - Elastic bandages
 - Adhesive tape
 - Tinactin
 - Nose spray
 - Cough drops
 - Throat lozenges
 - Robitussin
 - Ambesol
 - Tylenol and Ibuprofin
